North Primary School and Nursery Admissions Policy

Published admission number 2016/17: 60

Admissions are dealt with by Planning and Admissions Department at County Hall. The school assists parents with their applications when required.

Admissions Policy

There is no guarantee of a place for children living in the priority admissions area. In the event of oversubscription places will be allocated using the following criteria in the order given:

- 1. Looked After Children and previously looked after children (as defined on page 14 of the Primary Education in Essex 2016/2017 booklet);
- 2. children living with a sibling attending the school;
- 3. children living in the priority admissions area
- 4. remaining applications.

In the event of oversubscription within any of the above criteria, priority will be determined by straight line distance from home to school, those living closest being given the highest priority.

Nursery

The Nursery has places for 26 children in each session. Children attend morning Nursery or afternoon Nursery. Each session lasts two and a half hours.

Parents can register their child on the waiting list after their second birthday. Children are placed on the waiting list in age order. Children are eligible for a funded place in Nursery the term after their third birthday, as shown below. Parents are offered a place when a space becomes available.

Date of birth

1st April to 31st August 1st September to 31st December 1st January to 31st March

Eligible for a funded place in Nursery from

Autumn term following third birthday
Spring following third birthday
Summer term following third birthday

In the event of 2 or more children sharing a birthday and only one space being available the place will be allocated in accordance with the admissions criteria for the main school (as shown above).
