Extended Nursery Sessions Starting in Autumn Term

Following our consultation with parents earlier in the year, we are now able to confirm that we will be extending our nursery provision with effect from September, to offer up to 30 hours of funded nursery education to families who are eligible.

All of the children who attend nursery will be offered 15 hours per week (morning sessions 8.30 to 11.30am or afternoon sessions 12.30 to 3.30pm). In addition to this, eligible families will be able to combine morning and afternoon sessions to cover the whole school day (8.30 am to 3.30pm). Parents can check if they are eligible on www.childcarechoices.gov.uk

This is an excellent opportunity to help meet the demand for good quality, teacher-led nursery education to give children a good start to their school careers.

If you are looking for nursery provision for children who are 3 years old before 31st August 2017, please speak to the office staff for more information.

Earrings in PE lessons

A reminder that children are not allowed to wear earrings during PE lessons. If you are thinking of your child getting their ears pierced, it is recommended that this is done at the start of the summer holidays.

On PE days, children either need to have their earrings taken out before school or be able to remove them on their own and have a container to keep them in.

If children cannot take earrings out they will have to sit out of PE until they can remove their earrings. PE is very important. We do not want children to miss out.
