A number of children who belong to organisations such as the guides, brownies and boys brigade came to school in their uniforms in recognition of World Thinking Day. The pride in their uniforms was obvious. Who better than Sir Bob to talk to the children about this than Sir Bob, who has a long association with the Colchester scouting movement.

He told the children about the reasons for this day, celebrated around the world on February 22nd, when children think about children around the world who do not enjoy all the rights that most have, such as immediate access to clean water. 
Children can invite other family members if it is not possible for grandparents to attend.
