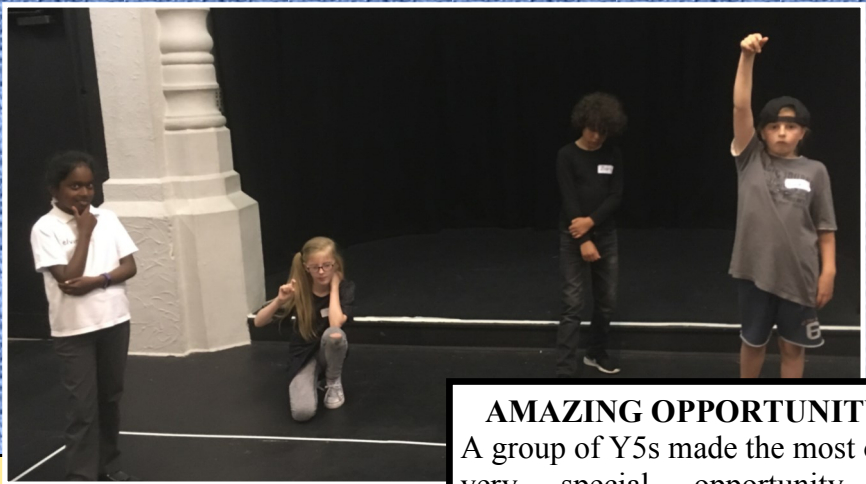


The weather is set fair for a lovely summer's evening.
