For the past couple of years annual attendance figures have been shared with parents. They make interesting reading. There are 190 days in one school year. Every day of absence is approximately 0.5%.

The School View

The mean average attendance rate for the whole year was 94.4%.

The median average attendance rate for the whole schools was 96.58%.

This variance shows the impact a significant minority of children, have on the school.

Looking behind the data and understanding every child's situation has enabled managers to identify appropriate responses to individual cases and there have been a number of successes. Some children with medical conditions will always have low attendance. Families can encounter problems which make it impossible for the child to attend school for a certain period of time. We aim to be sympathetic and supportive in these cases. But what is clear is that overall, year on year, approximately a third of the school population have an attendance rate below 95% and that persistent absentee figures have increased significantly. Improving attendance punctuality remain key school priorities.

The quality of education that staff provide at North is amazing. And they work flat out to support those children who are struggling to make progress. It is incredibly frustrating if those children have spasmodic attendance and/or are late on a regular basis.

No sooner do Year 6 settle in to school after their week of outdoor fun than they have to start thinking about applying to secondary school. Here is the information the local authority have asked to pass on to parents -

The new secondary school admission round opens on Thursday, 12 September 2019, for parents of current Year 6 children to apply for a secondary school (Year 7) place for September 2020.

The statutory national closing date for applications is 31st October 2019.

Applications can be made online via <u>www.essex.gov.uk/admissions</u>. 98% of parents in Essex applied online last year.

As with last year, we are not sending letters to parents about making an application. All of the application information is available on the website above.

The website also has a copy of the Secondary Education in Essex 2020-21 booklet which contains details of all secondary school admission policies.
