A whole range of subjects were covered, with teachers making the most of the extra pairs of hands.

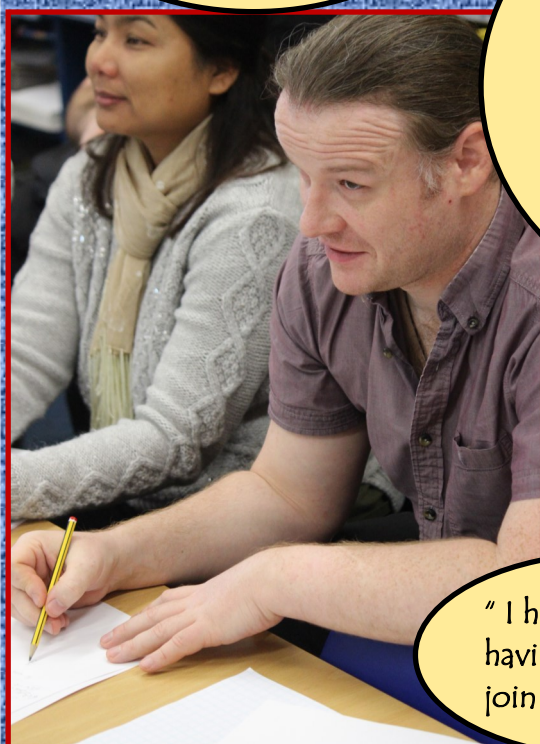
We are pleased that parents get a feel for how the classrooms work.
