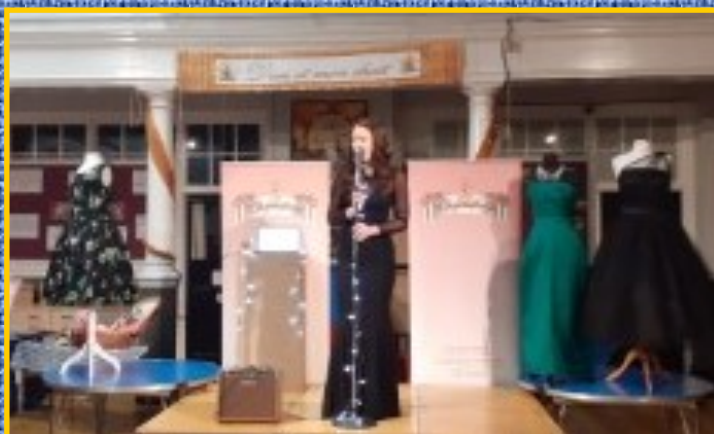


The concentration, the highs, the lows, the tension, the excitement. Programming, engineering, collaborating, being interviewed by the judges... All in a day's work for the North Roboters.
