12 Bar Blues

Made Simple

Left hand:

Use your left hand to play the three note chords. You can play one, two or all three of the notes in each chord depending on your ability.

Right hand:

Once you have found middle C you can use the D and the E notes adjacent to it to play the notes of the tune.

Solo:

Refer to the notes in the 'Keyboard technique' video and use them to improvise your solo.

Tip:

You can start by only using one hand at a time. When you are confident with each hand on their own, you can then try to put them together.
