Remember what your teacher has said to you, with regards to using the bow. Let the bow do the work, keep your strokes as smooth as possible and play each note for the full two beats. (Start with a down stroke followed by an up stroke).

## Violin:

Hold the violin correctly and make sure it is in tune. This music only requires open strings to play along with the tune.

## Tip:

When you can hold each note smoothly for the full two beats, you can then try to play your own rhythms over the tune.
