Covid, an Update (7th July 2021)

One class and their staff are isolating – two pupils in that class have tested positive for Covid. 1 member of staff has been told to isolate by T&T.

Another member of staff is having to look after her young child (who attends another school) and is having to isolate because of a positive case in her class.

A number of children are isolating because a parent has tested positive.

A number of children have been sent home this week because they are showing symptoms and they and their household are isolating until they get the results of a PCR test.

Mixing in society has increased and the infection rate is rising. This is triggering T&T alerts everywhere.

Parents are exasperated that school rules and society rules are so different – "Why can 60 000 people go to Wembley and parents can't attend a school sports day?" is a perfectly reasonable question.

And I am sure you know that the bubble rules are likely to be lifted from the $19^{th} - 2$ days before the end of term.

Our priority is to get through the term without any more children and staff being sent home to isolate.

We do not want to sabotage the Year 6's last attempt at enjoying their residential trip to Mersea.

Nor do we want to have the start of the holiday ruined for families and staff forced to isolate.

So, please be patient - we will not be changing any rules for the last two days.

What Will September Look Like?

The government guidelines relax certain rules with the warning that bubbles may have to be re-introduced if there are local outbreaks!

Some of the measures we have introduced have improved how the school operates so will continue. Others are up for review. The school council have asked for the views of pupils on four questions. Staff are being consulted as well. We are interested in the views of parents too. Have a look at the table below.
