## The Life You Can Save

### Harvest 2021

On the 20th we will be holding our harvest festival, a time when we think about those less fortunate and how we can help them. Obviously this fits in perfectly with this term's assembly theme, CHARITY.

We are going to do things slightly differently this year. For two reasons. Firstly, I will be asking you to make contributions to Children in Need's Happy Heads Charity in November, especially as some of our children will be featured on TV on CIN night, November 19th. [Filming for this will be on November 5th, dressing up required, details to follow.] And I do not like to make too many demands on you for money. Secondly, we have had an amazing offer by a very kind family who have introduced me to the The Life You Can Save organisation. And the family's (who would prefer to remain anonymous) brilliant idea which I am adopting for harvest is as follows...

Three charities will be highlighted. And the children will get to decide which charity they would like to support and they will find out the difference they

can make. This family are giving the children £1 each to donate to their preferred charity. In Monday 16th's assembly I will explain everything to the children.

The teachers will give every child a token worth one pound. On Monday or Tuesday they can donate it to one of the three charities. There will be pots in every class.

The tokens will be counted and totalled up ready to share in the Harvest Assembly on Wednesday. Unlike Asda or Tesco's it is not the one with the most tokens that gets the money. Each charity will get one pound for every token it has received.

The Harvest Assembly on Wednesday will be a recap of the work of the charities, songs will be sung and I will announce how much money is going to each charity – and the difference that amount of money can make.

I will let you know how the money will be distributed and the difference it will make.
