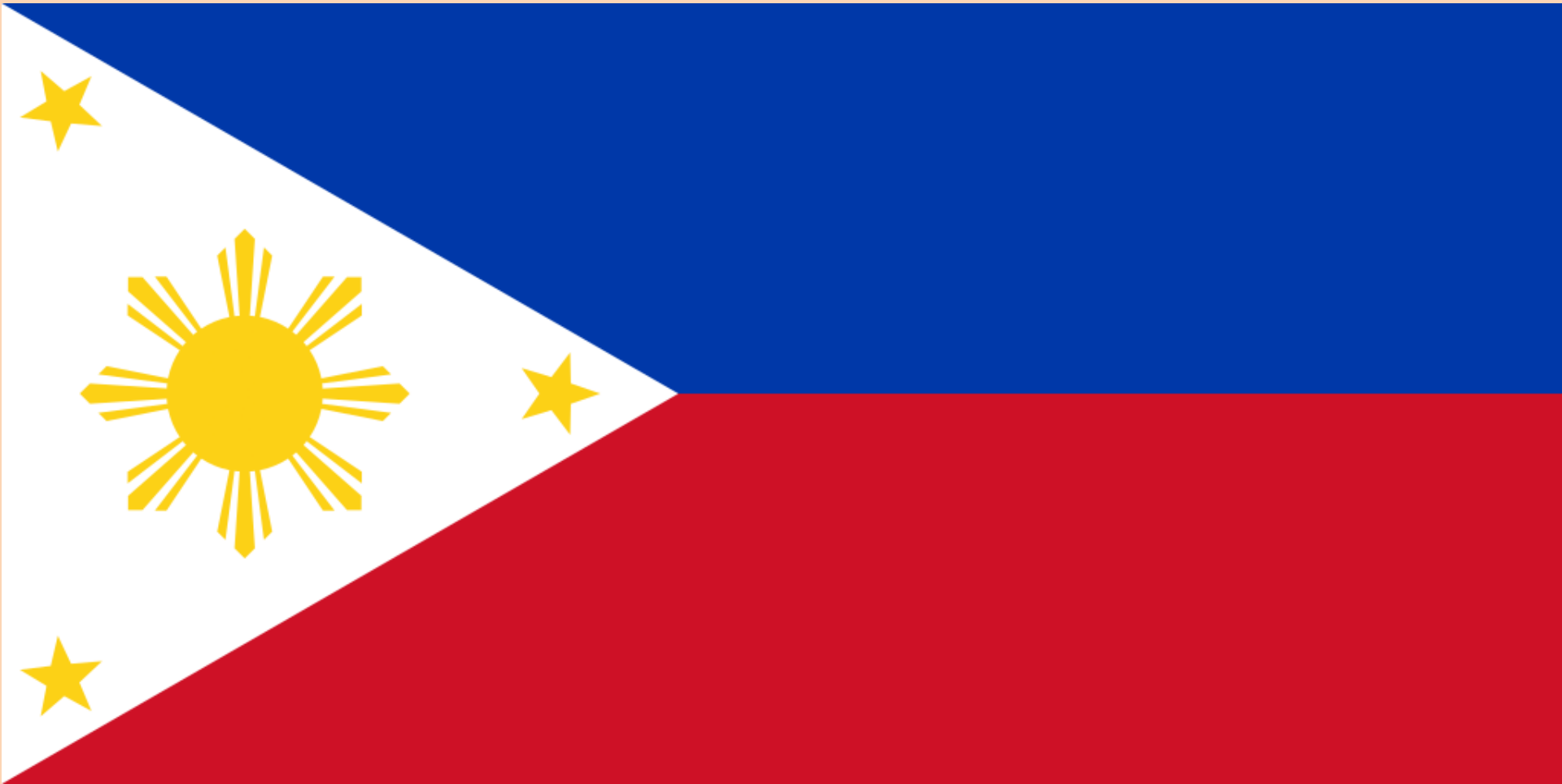

a [rainy season](#) from June to November,

and a cool dry season from December to February.
