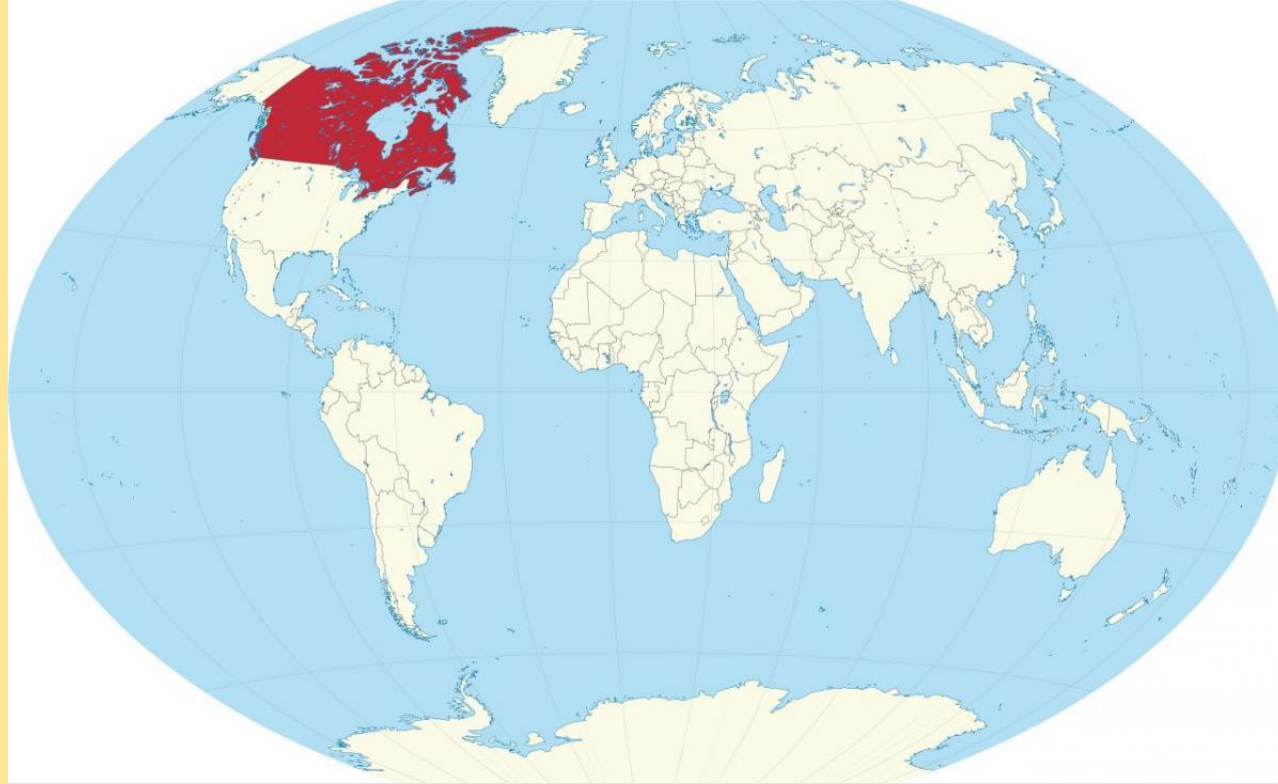




Hello! This is my assembly of Canada!
