#### THE NUTCRACKER - A SUITE TREAT

On the 3rd, 300 children set off excitedly for Charter Hall. They were in for a treat - a live music concert. with a twist. The concert underscored how timeless works like *The Nutcracker* can adapt across genres, offering audiences both refinement and innovation.

The school concert offered a delightful juxtaposition of two interpretations of The Nutcracker: Tchaikovsky's classical masterpiece and Duke Ellington's jazzy reimagining. The event began with a traditional rendition the Essex Youth Orchestra, highlighting Tchaikovsky's elegance and precision. Students performed pieces like "The Dance of the Sugar Plum Fairy" with careful attention to the composer's intricate melodies, evoking the enchanting spirit of the original ballet. The shimmering celesta and sweeping orchestration transported the audience to a whimsical, snowy world.

In contrast, the **Essex Youth Jazz Band** brought a vibrant energy, transforming the familiar tunes into swinging jazz arrangements. Pieces like "Sugar Rum Cherry" showcased bold brass, syncopated rhythms, and improvisational flair, drawing appreciative nods from the audience. The students embraced the style's freedom, adding a playful twist to the classical framework.

Watching musicians play brings the music to life and inspires our own apprentice musicians. A great afternoon. With thanks to all the adults who helped to escort the children to the Hall.
